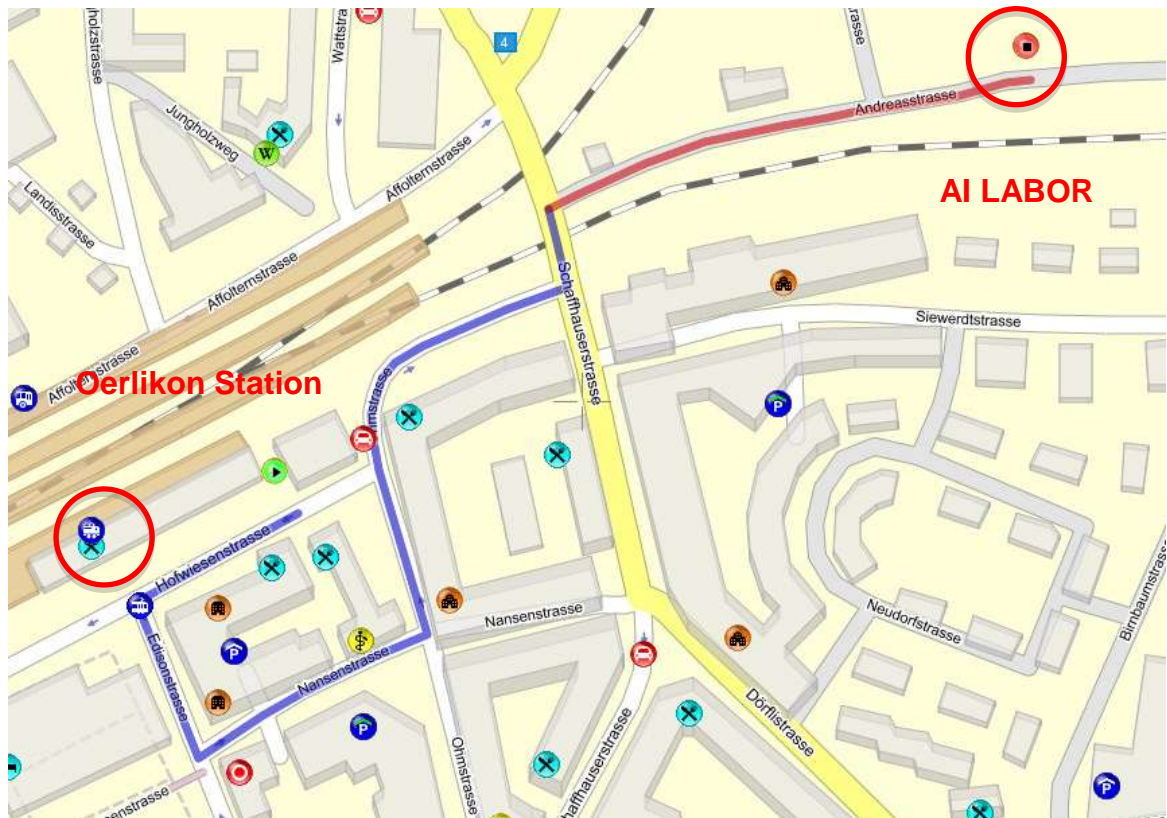
## Travel Information

From Zurich Main Station:

At the main station walk to the head of the train and follow any signs to "Bahnhofplatz" (tram 10, just next to main station) or check on the big wall for the next train to Oerlikon. If you arrived by train and haven't yet got a tram or train ticket, you must now buy one from the blue ticket machine. Depending on your needs, you can buy a day ticket which is valid for 24 hours for all trams and buses in the main zone (zone 10) of the.

From the main station you reach the AI Lab in six minutes with train or in 25 minutes with tram no. 10 (direction *Airport* or *Bahnhof Oerlikon*).

### Sightseeing in Zurich and Switzerland

- Zurich offers various attractions and museums and has a nice down-town shopping area. Here are some highlights:
- Kunsthaus – Switzerland’s most important art gallery contains a collection from all the important periods of European art – from the Middle Ages through to the present.
- Rietberg Museum – the museum houses non-European art, particularly from India, China and Africa.
- Bahnhofstrasse – the mile-long street of banks featuring exclusive fashion boutiques is the place to go shopping.
- Zurich Zoo – Tram 6 will take you uphill to get a beautiful view of Zurich City, with the possibility to take a very nice walk to the impressive Zurich Zoo.
- Old town – full of art galleries, antique and book shops, roaming in the old town is a pleasant way to discover the historical side of Zurich.
- Niederdorf - during the day this is a pedestrian zone and a shopper's paradise with lots of boutiques hidden away in a patchwork of alleys. At night the many bars, restaurants and street artists turn the Niederdorf into an exciting and colorful center of entertainment.
